	Over rough mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth.
	Continue descent; desc. 26 ft. over SW. slope.
.88	Head of gulch, 10 lks. wide, drains N.; asc. 22 ft. over SSE. slope.
7.96	Top of spur, slopes SW.; desc. 17 ft. over NW. slope.
15.13	Wash, 50 lks. wide, 12 ft. deep, drains NW.
19.66	Wash, 80 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, drains NE.; asc. 227 ft. over NE. slope.
31.90	Point of spur, slopes NNE.; desc. 168 ft. over NW. slope.
36.42	Gulch, 60 lks. wide, drains N.; asc. 170 ft. over E. slope to cor.
39.28	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

	Continue over mountainous land; asc. 41 ft. over E. slope.
42.16	Rocky spur, slopes N.; desc. 100 ft. over W. slope.
51.37	Point of rocky spur, slopes N.; desc. 172 ft. over W. slope.
55.32	Bottom of canyon, 2 chs. wide, drains NE.; asc. 150 ft. over steep rocky E. slope.
61.57	Point of spur, slopes NE.; desc. 251 ft. over NW. slope.
67.03	Point of spur, slopes NNW.
70.08	Point of spur, slopes NW.
74.57	Gulch, 50 lks. wide, drains N.; asc. 31 ft. over NE. slope.
76.40	Point of spur, slopes NW.; desc. 68 ft. over NW. slope.
78.41	The cor. of Ts. 23 and 24 S., Rs. 60 and 61 E., which is monumented with a trachyte stone, 25 x 20 x 10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 2 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.
