Chains

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered undergrowth; along W. side of large ridge; asc. 23 ft. along W. slope.

10.00 Top of ascent, slopes W.; continue over nearly level land.

23.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains W.

26.00 Begin descent; desc. 34 ft. over WNW. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

78.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains W.

80.00 Point for the cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 48 and 49 E.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
