General Description

The general elevation of the township ranges from approximately 2450 feet above sea level in the southern portion to 2700 feet in the northwest portion. Approximately 90 per cent of the township is nearly level land and 10 per cent of the land, located in the northwest portion of the township, is gently to heavily rolling land covered with igneous rocks.
