#### General Description

The general elevation of the township ranges from approximately 2420 feet above sea level in the southwest portion to 2500 feet in the northwest portion and 3000 feet in the eastern central portion of the township. The eastern half of the township ranges from rough mountainous land in the east central portion to gently rolling, and the western half of the township is nearly level land.

The soil is a sandy and gravelly loam.

The township is covered with a fairly heavy growth of sagebrush, greasewood, and creosote bush, with a sparse growth of native grasses. There are no flowing streams or springs in the township.
