General Description

The land within the portion of Township 45 North, Range 33 East, which was dependently resurveyed, is level to nearly level, except sections 28, 29, 31, 32 and 33 which are fairly rough hills, with a general east slope. The overall drainage is easterly, the elevation ranging from about 4300 to 5000 ft. above sea level.

The soil is a medium sandy loam in the low land, and sandy gravel and rocks in the hills, with a heavy growth of sagebrush.

There are secondary roads entering all the sections, most of them bearing in a general north and south direction.

The first two tiers of sections on the eastern side of the township, are practically covered by homestead entries, of which many have been approved, and the ground is under cultivation.

There are no apparent mineral deposits within the township.
