Chains

No evidence of original cor.

Desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.

52.20 Wash, drains NW.; desc. 40 ft. over rolling desert land.

57.40 Unimproved road, bears NW. and S. irregularly; desc. 20 ft. over rolling desert land covered with large boulders.

81.40 The cor. of Tps. 23 and 24 S., Rs. 61 and 62 E. mkd. by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, broken.

Soil, shallow gravel and rocks.

From the cor. of T. 23 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E. mkd. by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

From this cor. the closing cor. of T. 24 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E. bears N. 89° 54' E., 17.21 chs. dist., mkd. by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the independent resurvey of the east bdy. of T. 24 S., R. 62 E.

N. 89° 32' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 23 S., R. 62 E.

Over rolling desert land, covered with large boulders; asc. 50 ft. over E. slope.

22.70 Base of high black hill, bears N. and irregularly S., 15 chs.; asc. 390 ft. over steep SE. slope.

40.04 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 23 S., R. 62 E., at proportionate dist.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid stone, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

76.00 Wash, 4 ft. deep, 50 lks. wide, drains S. 15 chs. to junction; asc. 50 ft. over E. slope.

80.08 Point for the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 23 S., R. 62 E., at proportionate dist.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
