Chains

95.50 Bottom of descent; draw, 5 lks. wide, drains NNE., asc. 30 ft. over ENE. slope.

99.05 Intersect E. bdy. of sec. 25, T. 26 S., R. 61 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.
