## General Description

T. 17 S., R. 65 E., consists entirely of rolling desert land covered with black brush, creosote bush and scattered cactus. No timber is found in the vicinity. The soil is sandy gravel on the west portion and rocky clay loam on the east portion. The general drainage and exposure is northwest.

The American Borax Road enters the township on the north boundary of section 8, bears southeast and leaves the township on the south boundary of section 34. The Arrowhead Trail enters the township on the south boundary of section 36 and leaves it on the east boundary of section 25. A telephone line with a road parallel enters the township on the south boundary of section 31 and leaves it on the north boundary of section 11. The entire township can be traveled with four wheel drive vehicle. A windmill and cattle corral are located in the southeast quarter of section 31.

The general elevation is from 2,000 to 2,400 feet above sea level.

No water was nated during this survey.
