Chains

General Description

The region crossed by the east boundary of T. 19 S., R. 65 E. is made up entirely of mountain desert land. The south portion bears along the east slopes of the Muddy Mountains, and the north portion extends through the extreme west part of White Basin. The terrain over which this survey extends is broken by numerous deep washes and gullies draining generally east to Echo Wash.

The vegetation consists of scattered black brush, cresote bush, and bunch grass. There is no timber in this vicinity.

The soil is shallow sand and clay loam and very rocky, with the exception of a few clay and gypsum spots in White Basin.

The mean elevation above sea level along this boundary is about 3000 ft.

No water was noted during the survey.
