Chains

From this cor. U. S. M. M. No. 313 bears S. 38° 46' E., 19.655 chs. dist.

East, along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over rolling land, through desert shrubs.

Asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.

1.60 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 100 ft. over NE. slope.

9.40 Slope changes to a northerly direction; desc. 120 ft.

35.60 Wash, 1.00 ch. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains S. 25° W.; thence over nearly level land.

40.00 Point for the ½ sec. cor. of sec. 31.

Set an iron post, 30 ins., long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to brass cap mkd.
