Chains

Land, rolling.  
Soil, rocky and sandy silt.  
Timber, none.  
Undergrowth, creosote bush, mountain rush and cacti.

North, along the W. bdy. of sec. 6.

Over rolling land; desc. 10 ft. over N. slope.

6.20 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.

33.00 Base of sandstone outcrop; asc. 70 ft. over distorted surface.

38.40 Top of ascent; desc. 20 ft. over steep N. sloping sandstone.

40.00 True point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6 falls on steep N. sloping slickrock where it is impractical to set the monument.

Desc. 40 ft. over N. sloping slickrock.

44.00 Base of sandstone outcrop.

44.52 Point selected for the witness  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., over a cross (X) cut in bedrock, supported in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
