Chains

Bury old cor. stone alongside iron post.

N. 0° 47' E., beginning new measurement.

Over SE. slope, through sagebrush and shadscale.

7.00 Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains S. 20° E.

40.61 The cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N., Rs. 31 and 32 E., mkd. by a stone 13x9x6 ins. firmly set in mound of stone, with 6 grooves on N., S., E. and W. faces.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
