GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed within the township is located in Antelope Valley The land is nearly level with the exception of section 5, 22, and 23, which are low mountainous. The elevation varies from 4,900 feet above sea level to 5,800 feet above sea level.

The area drains northerly into Cane Creek, which drains northeasterly into Reese River. The soil varies from light sandy clay on the desert to gravel, rock, clay and sand on the mountains. The vegetation is composted of medium growth of shadscale and scattered white sage. A number of trail roads provide access to all areas of the township.

A number of water holes are located in section 5.
