From the above point, the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 26 N., R. 41 E., bears S. 89° 50' E., 4.31 chs. and is monumented by an iron post, set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Township 25 North, Range 41 East

General Description

The land within the dependently resurveyed portion of T. 25 N., R. 41E. is level to nearly level, except for rough hills along the east boundary of sections 24, 25 and 36, and low rolling hills along the north boundary of the township. The drainage is northeast except on the north boundary where it is southerly. The elevation varies from about 4,900 feet above sea level in the valley, to 5,700 feet above sea level in the hills.

The soil is loam in the valley, gravel and rocks in the hills, with undergrowth of sagebrush and shadscale.

There are roads leaving the Cottonwood Ranch in north, south, east and west directions.

There is considerable homestead activity in this township. Almost the whole valley has been covered by homestead entries since the first good water well was drilled in 1959.

There are no apparent mineral deposits within the township.
