

Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 24 N., R. 41 E.

Chains

General Description

The land in this township is located in Antelope Valley and is nearly level and gently rolling desert. The average elevation is approximately 4900 feet above sea level. The area drains northerly through the township, thence northeasterly to Reese River.

The soil is composed of light sandy clay, with areas of light sandy clay and gravel. The vegetation is medium growth of shadscale and white sage.

Access into the township is provided by numerous desert roads. No springs or water holes were found in the township.
