	Over nearly level land, through sagebrush and shadscale.
28.50	Road, NW. and SE.
39.70	Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains N.
40.71	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

51.50	Reese River, 35 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains N.
81.42	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
	Land, nearly level. Soil, loam. Vegetation, sagebrush and shadscale.
	N. 1° 33' E., bet. secs. 1 and 2.
	Over nearly level land, through sagebrush and shadscale.
40.47	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, mkd. by a small pile of stones, with old rotten pegs lying near them, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position for the original cor.

	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	From this point the original standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, now an angle point, bears S. 89° 46' E., 4.84 chs. dist.
