T6N R40E

Deposit broken glass alongside iron post.

Raise a mound of stone N. of cor.

81.84 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, desert vegetation.

N. 1° 47' E., bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Over nearly level land, through desert vegetation.

39.45 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

T6N R40E

Deposit broken glass alongside iron post.

Raise a mound of stone W. of cor.

78.76 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., which is monumented with an iron post, set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the resurvey of T. 7 N., R. 40 E.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, desert vegetation.

From the standard cor. of secs. 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 02° 01' W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Over rolling land, through desert vegetation.

20.00 Asc. over rocky S. slope.

32.60 Ridge, bears W. and about 4 chs. E.; desc. 40 ft. over rocky N. to NE. slope.

40.58 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.
