GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within T. 6 N., R. 40 E. is principally rolling to broken, easterly to southerly exposure and drainage. The elevation of the township ranges from about 5,000 feet in the southeast corner of the township to about 5,500 feet near the southwest corner.

The soil is principally a light sandy loam with numerous stone outcrops in the west and southwest sections; no timber and the undergrowth is desert vegetation.

There is one improved dirt road bearing northwesterly from the south boundary of section 36 to the north boundary of section 5. There are a few other unimproved rut or trail roads into the township.

Mineral Survey No. 4414, Little Bill lode, extends into section 32. There was no water noted within the township.
