

## Dependent Resurvey of the West Boundary of T. 7 N., R. 40 E.

Chains

Deposit original stone alongside iron post.

Deposit broken glass alongside iron post.

Raise a mound of stone W. of cor.

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From the same point the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, Tps. 7 and 8 N., R. 39 E., bears W. 41.13 chs. dist., which is monumented by a stone, 10x8x8 ins., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
