GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within T. 7 N., R. 40 E. is principally nearly level to rolling, with the land in the northeast section rough and broken, mountainous, with a southerly exposure and drainage. The elevation of the township ranges from about 5,000 ft. above sea level along the south boundary to a maximum of 6,200 ft. near the northeast corner.

The soil is principally a shallow sand to sandy loam, with numerous rock outcrops, covered with a short undergrowth of desert vegetation. No timber was found within this township.

There are two improved dirt roads entering the south boundary of of section 32 from Tonopah, Nevada and leaving from the west boundary of section 19 to Ione and Gabbs Valley; one from Tonopah, Nevada enters on the east boundary of section 36 and leaves the north boundary of section 4. There are a few other unimproved rut and trail roads within the township.
