

SUBDIVISION OF A PORTION OF SECTION 18, T. 15 S., R. 50 E.

Chains

- Thence from the W 1/16 sec. cor. on the S. bdy. of Sec. 18,
N. 0° 03' W., on the N. and S. center line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
- 6.40 The center of J.H.Vernon's service station and residence, a frame building 16 x 30 ft., bears East 50 lks. distant.
- 9.55 State highway No. 29, oiled surface, bears E. and SW. on a curve.
- 10.21 U.S. Highway No. 95, oiled surface, bears N. 72° 34' W. and S. 72° 34' E.
- 20.00 Intersect the E. and W. center line thru the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 18.

Soil, sandy and gravelly, 2nd rate.

Undergrowth, creosote brush.
Grazing, fair.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The land adjacent to and within this surveyed area is a nearly level arid desert type covered with a scant growth of creosote brush, some cactii, and minor other desert vegetation. It is not suited to the usual agricultural purposes.

A resident on the land and the applicant for the survey, Joseph H. Vernon, has erected a combination residence and service station along the south edge of the U S Highway No. 95, situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18.
