## Chains

The east boundary, a portion of the north boundary and the south boundary of secs. 32 and 33 and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 11 N., R. 40 E., was surveyed by Hatch, Barker and Bridges in 1873.

The following field notes are those of the remonumentation of certain identified original corners on S. Bdy. of T. 11 N., R. 40 E., M.D. Mer., Nevada. The position of each corner was marked by the original monument.

The corners remonumented were selected by the Forest Service as being adjacent to, or controlling the boundaries of Forest Service Lands. The remonumentation was requested by and accomplished in cooperation with the Forest Service.

South Bdy. T. 11 N., R. 40 E. (2nd Stan. Par. N.)

At the S.C. of secs. 31 and 32, on S. bdy. T. 11 N., R. 40 E., marked by a granite stone, 24x11x8 ins, firmly set, marked with 1 notch on W. and 5 notches on E. edge (no SC found); witnessed by a scattered mound of stone, around cor.

At cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over glass deposit, and with original cor. stone buried on N. side of post; brass cap mkd.

SC T11N R40E S31 S32

1961

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around cor.

Corner is located on a gradual E. slope, in dense sagebrush, 15 lks. S. of small drain, course E.

At the ½ sec. cor. on S. bdy. sec. 32, T. 11 N., R. 40 E., identical with cor. No. 1, HES No. 125; the ½ sec. cor. is mkd. by a granite stone, 17x10x5 ins., firmly set, mkd. ½ on N. face, the HES cor. is a granite stone, 25x12x7 ins., mkd. 1 HES 125 on S. face, and was firmly set against the S. edge of the ½ sec. cor. stone; no accessories found.

At the point for the 1/2 sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, with the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. stone buried on N. side, and the HES stone buried on S. side of post. Brass cap mkd.

T11N R40E ½ S,32 1 HES 125

1961

Place a collar of rock around post.

Corner is located in E. and W. wire fence, and is along N. side of corral. House bears about SW. 3 chs. dist.
