Homestead Entry Survey No. 125, in sec. 5, T. 10 N., R. 40 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, was executed by F. C. Harman, Forest Ranger in 1916.


The following field notes are those of the remonumentation of identified original corners on Homestead Entry Survey No. 125, located in approximately sec. 5 of unsurveyed T. 10 N., R. 40 E., M. D. Mer., Nevada. The corners remonumented were selected by the Forest Service as being adjacent to, or controlling the boundaries of Forest Service Lands. The remonumentation was requested by, and accomplished in cooperation with the Forest Service.

Cor. No. 1, HES No. 125 is identical with the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 11 N., R. 40 E., for description and remonumentation refer to the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. in these notes.

At cor. No. 2, HES No. 125, on the S. bdy. of sec. 32, T. 11 N., R. 40 E., monumented by a granite stone, 25x12x6 ins., firmly set, marked 2 HES 125 on side facing claim, witnessed by a scattered mound of stone to the S.

At cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over broken glass, with orig. cor. stone buried on W. side of post; brass cap marked



1961

Place collar of rock around, and rebuild mound of stone, S. of post.

Corner is located in E. and W. wire fence, and about 2 chs. W. of its junction with fences extending N., and S.

At cor. No. 3, HES No. 125, monumented by a granite stone, 24x12x9 ins., mkd. 3 HES 125 on side facing claim, and a cross on top (destroyed) firmly set in the ground; witnessed by a small mound of stone to NW.

At cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with orig. cor. stone buried on N. side; brass cap mkd.

Cor. located in flat land, approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ chs. N. of fence along S. side, and about $2\frac{1}{2}$ chs. W. of fence along E. side of claim,

Cor. No. 4 is missing, falls in cleared land.
