## TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 61 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

These field notes are those of the Remonumentation of  
a Corner of the Survey Executed by Newton E. Potter,  
U.S. Surveyor, in 1915.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, monumented with a  
basalt stone, 20x8x4 ins., firmly set 8 ins. in the  
ground, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, with a mound of stone W.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
