CHAINS

bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

The closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a granite stone, 16x12x7 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. 5 notches on the E. edge, 1 notch on the W. face and 6 notches and CC on the S. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original corner stone and set a steel fence post alongside the iron post.

This cor. is located on a steep rocky W. slope. A prominent rocky peak, bears N. 45° W., 3.20 chs. dist.

These field notes are those of a remonumentation of certain corners of the survey executed by Taylor and Keddie, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1902.

The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a lava stone, 20x8x8 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. 3 grooves on the N. and S. faces.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
