

## TOWNSHIP 44 NORTH, RANGE 55 EAST

CHAINS

This cor. is located on top of a low spur, sloping W.

The closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a limestone, 16x8x6 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. 5 notches on the E. edge, 1 notch on the W. edge and CC on the S. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

These field notes are those of a remonumentation of certain corners of the survey executed by Taylor and Keddie, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1902.

The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a lava stone, 20x10x5 ins., firmly set and plainly mkd. ¼ on the N. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
