## Chains

The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, which is marked by the remains of a mound of earth and collar of stone, and substantiated by ties to the original bearing trees

A pinon, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 44° 00' E., 96 1ks. dist., mkd. as described in the official record. (Record).

A pinon, 10 ins. diam.; bears S. 72° 00' E., 94 lks. dist., mkd. as described in the official record. (Record).

A pinon, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 74° 00' W., 186 lks. dist., mkd. as described in the official record. (Record).

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 8 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., which is marked by a granite stone,  $30 \times 20 \times 10$  ins., above ground, firmly set in ground, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

Reset the marked stone, alongside the iron post.

The cor. of Tps. 17 and 18 S., Rs. 55 and 56 E., which is marked by a granite stone, 30x15x6 ins., above ground, firmly set in ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
