N. 88° 33' W., bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

35.70 Asc. 125 ft. over E. slope of ridge.

40.24 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top of cap, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The surveyed land within this township is nearly level to gently rolling with the exception of Rattlesnake ridge, which covers most of sec. 7, the NE. cor. of sec. 18 and the NW. cor. of sec. 17. The elevation varies
