40.08 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, monumented with the remains of the original wood post. There are no legible scribe markings.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

At the corner point
