39.39	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div>T44N R31E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 S 1 1962</div> <p>Asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.</p>
59.00	Spur, bears SW.; continue along W. slope.
67.10	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.
79.19	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the N. bdy.</p> <p>Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and buttonbrush.</p>
38.26	<p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 43 N., R. 31 E.</p> <p>N. $1^{\circ} 26'$ E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div>T44N R31E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 S 35 1962</div>
76.52	<p>The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, monumented with the remains of the original wood post.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div>T44N R31E S 27 S 26 S 34 S 35 1962</div> <p>Reset the original wood post alongside the iron post.</p>
