DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BDY., T. 43 N., R. 31 E.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed
by Skinner, Garside and Preble, Deputy Surveyors
in 1873.

The cor. of Tps., 42 and 43 N., R. 31 and 32 E.,
monumented with the original squared woodpost, 1x1x36
ins. long, there are no legible marks, loosely set.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. in diam., 24
ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass
cap mkd.

Reset original woodpost alongside the iron post.

N. 0° 56' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

40.28 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence
of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. in diam., 24
ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass
cap mkd.

80.56 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence
of the original corner.
