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<p>CHAINS 20.40</p>	<p>Knott Creek, in concrete ditch, 3 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N. 64° 47' W. and S. 64° 47' E.</p>
<p>43.52</p>	<p>The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the N. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, shadscale and buttonbrush.</p>
<p>22.20</p>	<p>From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., and iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 42 N., R. 27 E.</p> <p>N. 1° 33' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 240 ft. over N. slope.</p> <p>Base of steep descent, bears E. and W., continue over rolling land, draining NE.</p>
<p>33.40</p>	<p>Ravine, drains NE.</p>
<p>42.47</p>	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T43N R27E ¼ S 33 S 34 1962</p> <p>Desc. gradually over rolling NE. slope.</p>
<p>76.80</p>	<p>Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NE.</p>
<p>84.94</p>	<p>The cor. of secs. 27 and 34, monumented with a stone, 9x6x4 ins., mkd. with 1 notch on the S. face and 3 notches on the E. face, and firmly set in a mound of stone.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T43N R27E S 27 S 34 1962</p> <p>Bury the original cornerstone alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Land, rolling. Soil, Sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and buttonbrush.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.</p> <p>S. 89° 34' W., bet. secs. 27 and 34.</p> <p>Over meadow.</p>
