Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and buttonbrush. GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land surveyed within this township is rolling to nearly level desert land. The area is drained northerly by Craine Creek and the water is used for irrigation by the Knott Creek Ranch, located in section 3. Principal users of the area are cattlemen. There is some land under cultivation in sections 3 and 4 and some meadow land along Craine Creek in sections 34 and 35. The soil varies from sandy clay along the creek and level valley land to sandy clay with rock and gravel on the rolling land. There is no timber. Access into the township is provided by desert roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
