Dependent Resurvey of the North Boundary,
T. 42 N., R. 27 E., Mount Diablo Meridian,
Nevada

Re-establishment of the survey executed by G. W. Garside,
Deputy Surveyor, in 1872.

The cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., R. 27 E., monumented with
a stone, 32x12x7 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone
and plainly mkd. with 6 notches of 4 sides.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft.
base, to cap with brass cap mkd.

Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

S. 87° 27' W. bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 100
ft. over SE. slope.

- 8.40 Trail road, bears N. and S.
- 9.60 Cove Creek, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains S.; asc.
190 ft. over steep E. slope.
- 14.80 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 60 ft. over rolling SW slp.
- 25.60 Base descent, slopes SE.; asc. 120 ft. over E. slope.
- 41.48 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with a stone,
8x6x2 ins. firmly set in a mound of stone, and plainly
mkd. ¼ on the N. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to
cap, with brass cap mkd.

Over mountainous land; asc. 270 ft. over steep E. slope.

- 8.70 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; thence across rolling
