| | <p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land surveyed within this township is rolling and broken mountains. The area is drained by Cove Creek which flows South-westerly and KnottCreek which flows North-westerly. There are several springs in the area and KnottCreek Reservoir is located in Section 8. The soil is sandy clay and rocky.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by a trail road to KnottCreek Reservoir.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during survey.</p> |
