Dependent Resurvey of the North Boundary, T. 44 N., R. 28 E.
Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada

Re-establishment of the Survey Executed by
Garside and Preble, Deputy Surveyors, in 1873

Beginning at the cor. of Tp. 44 and 45 N., Rs. 28 and 29 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the official record.

West, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 150 ft. over W. slope.

14.60 Ravine, drains SW.; asc. 210 ft. over E. slope.

26.00 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. 330 ft. over steep W. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

Desc. 20 ft. over W. slope.

41.00 Base of descent, bears N. and S.; asc. 30 ft. over E. slope.

57.10 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. 350 ft. over W. Slope.

68.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.; asc. 20ft. over E. slope.

72.90 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. 50 ft. over W. slope.

78.50 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains N. 20° W.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, monumented with a mound of stone, No mkd. stone found.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
