

CHAINS

Dependent Resurvey, W. Bdy., T. 43 N., R. 29 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Re-establishment of the survey executed by Skinner, Garside and Preble, Deputy Surveyors, in 1873

From the cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 28 and 29 E.

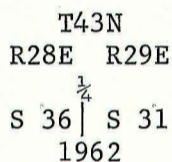
N. 0° 05' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth, asc. 90 ft. over S. slope.

5.60 Trail road, bears SE. and N. 40 ° W.,; asc. 450 ft. over S. slope.

41.15 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Asc. 260 ft. over S. slope.

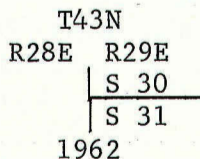
66.60 Top of ridge, projects N. 85° E.,; desc. 190 ft. over N. slope.

75.80 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.

82.30 The cor. of secs. 30 and 31, monumented with a trapstone, 14x6x2 ins., plainly mkd. with 1 notch on the S. face and 6 notches on the E. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.



Bury the original corner stone, alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush and picklebrush.

N. 0° 03' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 30.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth.
