Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A balsam fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.61½°E., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R19E S6 BT.

A balsam fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S.53°E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R19E S7 BT.

A balsam fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.33°W., 26 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R18E S12 BT.

A balsam fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.32°W., 35 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R18E S1 BT.

Land, rough mountainous.
Soil, coarse loam, 2d rate; decomposed granite, 3d rate; rocky, 4th rate.
Undergrowth, manzanita, deerbrush, bitter brush.
Timber, yellow pine, white pine, balsam fir, red fir.
Grazing, fair to poor.

N.0°02'E., bet. secs. 1 and 6. (S½ mile)

Descend 20 ft. along broken NW. slope of rough mountainous land, thru medium heavy large timber and scattering low undergrowth.

- 1.50 Ravine, course W.; ascend 140 ft. on rocky S. slope.
- 5.60 Short rocky spur, slopes W.; from NE.; descend 190 ft. on broken W. slope.
- 32.90 Small spring branch, course N.70°W.; ascend 40 ft. on W. slope.
- 39.78 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, which is monumented with a decayed pine post, 5 ins. diam., 18 ins. above ground, mkd. 1/4 S on smoothed W. side, in center of a small mound of stone; from which the original bearing trees:
 - A yellow pine, 30 ins. diam., bears West, 20 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S BT on open old blaze.
 - The stump hole of a dead and fallen yellow pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.85°E., 13 lks. dist.
 - This tree is marked 1/4 S BT on open old blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.
