Intersect California-Nevada State Boundary line.

Point for closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

A white bark pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 78° W., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R18E S35 CC BT.

A white bark pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 19° E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R18E S36 CC BT.

Raise a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top.

From point of intersection Monument No. 3 on the Calif.-Nev. State Boundary bears S. 48° 42' E., 12.08 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary concurrently resurveyed under this group.

Descend 630 ft. on precipitous N. slope.

37.80 Head of ravine, drains N. 30° W., continue along steep W. slope.

39.81 The point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36 which is recovered in the center of a large embedded mound of stone; its position is verified by record course and distance to the original SW. bearing tree. No trace of the original monument was found.

from which the original bearing tree:

A yellow pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 109 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT plainly visible in the partially overgrown portion of the blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a large supporting mound of stone to top of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
