

## Dependent Resurvey E. Bdy. of T. 11 N., R. 20 E.

Chains	<p>from which</p> <p>A pinon, 11 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 47 lks. dist., mkd. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S30 BT.</p> <p>A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears N.37<math>\frac{1}{4}</math>°W., 17 lks. dist., mkd. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S25 BT.</p> <p>Thence</p> <p>S.0°01'E., bet. secs. 25 and 30. (South half mile.)</p> <p>Ascend 50 ft. over broken N. slope.</p> <p>6.90 Ridge, bears S.70°E. and N.70°W., from a point 1 chain westerly, a spur projects S.20°W., desc. along a broken W. slope thru heavy timber.</p> <p>40.07 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is monumented with a surfaced pinon post, 20 ins. long, with distinct scribe marks on all sides, in the center of a small mound of stones. Record connections to identified stumps of three of the original four bearing trees verifies the position of this corner.</p> <p>This now becomes Cor. No. 4 of Tract 55 and Cor.
