

Dependent Resurvey, Subdivision of T. 11 N., R. 20 E.

Chains

A pinon, 10 ins. diam., bears N.39 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 34 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R20E S26 BT.

Land, mountainous and rolling.
Soil, shallow clay loam and rocky, 3d and 4th rate.
Timber, yellow pine, pinon and juniper, mostly burned.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, mostly burned.
Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on E. bdy. of Tp., identical with Cor. No. 4 of Tract 55 and Cor. No. 1 of Tract 56.

West, bet. secs. 25 and 36. (East half mile.)

Descend 50 ft. over NW. slope of mountainous land, thru heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

3.50 Head of ravine, course S.20°E., soon turns to SW.; ascend 80 ft. on SE. slope.


10.70 Rocky knoll, on spur from N.; descend 105 ft. on SW. slope.

19.20 Change to SE. slope; ascend 50 ft.

20.50 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary line.

Point for closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A pinon, 12 ins. diam., bears N.21 $\frac{1}{4}$ °E., 92 lks. dist., mkd. S25 CC BT.

A pinon, 8 ins. diam., bears S.74 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R20E S36 CC BT.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, NE. of post.

From point of intersection, Monument No. 19 on the state boundary bears N.48°33'W., 13.15 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State boundary concurrently resurveyed under this group.

32.00 Spur, slopes SW.; descend 230 ft. on broken SW. slope.

40.05 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, determined from the original NE. bearing tree:

A pine stump, 10 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 18 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S on open old blaze.
