	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, to underlying rock, and in a mound of stone 3 ft. base, to cap, with brass cap mkd.

	Tip of Genoa Peak, bears N. 59° 27' W. (Distance not determined).
	From point of intersection, the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 11 N., R. 21 E., bears East, 10.77 chs. dist., which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky and sandy clay loam. Timber, pine and mahogany. Undergrowth, sage and laurel.
	At point for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, on N. bdy. of the Tp., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
