

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 10 N., R. 22 E.

Chains
78.05

Intersect the Second Std. Par. N. at proportionate distance thereon for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2. No trace of the original cor. was found.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a large supporting mound of stones, for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 102 lks. dist., mkd. T10N R22E S1 CC BT.

A pinon pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. $49\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 83 lks. dist., mkd. T10N R22E S2 CC BT.

From this cor., the std. cor. of secs. 35 and 36 bears East 11.48 chs. distant.

Land, South $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, rolling; balance, rough mountainous.
Soil, shallow coarse rocky clay loam, 3rd rate.
Timber, pinon pine, juniper.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush.
Grazing, fair to poor.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, $3\frac{1}{4}$ and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp.,
N. $0^{\circ} 25'$ E., bet. secs. $3\frac{1}{4}$ and 35, (South half mile.)

Over gentle rolling alkaline land thru medium dense undergrowth.

9.00 Leave rolling land and asc. 210 ft. over rocky S. slope.

30.30 Spur ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W., desc. 40 ft. over gradual N. slope.

40.16 Intersect the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is marked by a small mound of stones, almost completely embedded, of the same general appearance as other identified corners in this same portion of the township. The original corner stone was not found.

At point for cor. in center of mound,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
