All of section 19, T. 9 N., R. 23 E., Nevada is Nevada State Land under State Selection List # 10 dated June 16, 1880 and approved March 26, 1891, embracing a total of 616.46 acres, as shown on the official plat approved August 7, 1877.

Lots 3 and 4 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of this section embracing an area of 104.59 acres as shown on the above plat are invaded by the California-Nevada State Boundary and are surveyed as one unit which is designated Tract No. 37. The other subdivisions of this entry conform to the lines of the resurvey. There are no improvements on the ground and all tract boundaries are based upon a strictly dependent resurvey of the lines of Sec. 19.
