Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, at proportionate distance. No trace of the original cor. was found.

This cor. is now altered and refers and stands for the cor. of secs. 5 and 6, T. 7 N., R. 45 E. only.

At the proportionate point.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Grazing, fair.

N. 75° 31' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 6.

Over rolling mountainous land, through dense undergrowth, descend 10 ft.

5.90 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 30° E.; asc. 10 ft.

19.10 Wash, 15 lks. wide, with sloping banks 4 ft. high, course S. 35° E.; asc. 70 ft.

38.82 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 8 N., R. $44\frac{1}{2}$ E., which is 40.00 chs. in departure from the SE. cor. of T. 8 N., R. $44\frac{1}{2}$ E.
