Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate.
Timber, juniper and pinon pine; undergrowth, sagebrush.

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth, asc. 10 ft.

2.00 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 25 ft.

12.40 Wash, course S. 70° E.; asc. 35 ft.

38.61 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 9 N., R. 45 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a porphyry rock, 6x5x4 ins., mkd. with a cross (x), deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
