Chains

76.62 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Point for the closing corner of secs. 12 and 13.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S.36½°E., 81 lks. dist., mkd. T8N R44½E S13 CC BT

A pinon pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N.72°E., 82 lks. dist., mkd. T8N R44½E S12 CC BT

From point of intersection the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 13, on the E. bdy. of T.8 N., R.44 E., bears North, 28 lks. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam, medium texture, dry and shallow, grading to rocky, 3rd. rate.

Timber, pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush. Grazing, fair.

The point for the W. ¼ sec. cor., of sec. 13 is at midpoint on the W. bdy. of the section.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.54½°E., 154 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S13 BT

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S.80¼°E., 52 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S13 BT

From this corner the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, on the E. bdy. of T.8 N., R.44 E., bears North, 25 lks. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

West, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth; asc. 100 ft. over E. slope.
