

DEATH VALLEY NATIONAL MONUMENT
SURVEY OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 11 S., R. 43 E.

Chains	<p>The original cor. of Ts. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 43 and 44 E. is a basalt rock, 14x10x4 ins., firmly set in a large mound of stone, mkd. 6 notches on N., E., S. and W. edges. At this corner point, I set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original corner stone deposited at the base, for cor. of Ts. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 43 and 44 E., with brass cap mkd:</p> <div><div>T 10 S</div><div>R43E R44E</div><div>S 36 S 31</div><div>S 1 S 6</div><div>T 11 S</div><div>1942</div></div> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>Beginning at the above cor.,</p> <p>West, with the establishment of the N. bdy. of T. 11 S., R. 43 E., along the N. bdy. of Sec. 1, on a transit line describing the tangent, Asc. 70 ft. over steep NE. slope.</p> <div><div>3.80</div><div>Rocky ridge, bears N. and S., desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.</div></div> <div><div>13.00</div><div>Draw, drains NE., asc. 100 ft. over E. slope.</div></div> <div><div>29.20</div><div>Spur, slopes NE., continue along broken N. slope.</div></div> <div><div>31.60</div><div>Top of ascent, slopes N., desc. 130 ft. over NW. slope.</div></div> <div><div>40.00</div><div>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 9 ins. in the ground, over a cross (x) cut on bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:</div><div><div>$\frac{1}{4}$ S 1</div><div>1942</div></div><p>Continue descent of 40 ft. over NW. slope.</p><div><div>49.30</div><div>Draw, drains NE., asc. 180 ft. over E. slope.</div></div><div><div>71.30</div><div>Slope gradually changes from E. to gentle NE. slope. Asc. 50 ft.</div></div><div><div>80.00</div><div>N. 1 lk. from the tangent.</div><div>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1 and 2 only, with brass cap mkd.</div><div><div>S 2 S 1</div><div>T11S R43E</div><div>DVNM</div><div>1942</div></div><p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.</p><p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky and gravelly clay, 3rd rate. Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, black brush, bitter brush. Grazing, fair.</p><hr/><p>West, along the N. bdy. of Sec. 2, along the tangent line, Asc. gentle NE. slope thru medium dense undergrowth.</p></div></div>
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
