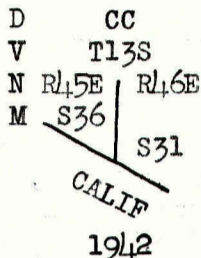

32.16 Intersect the California-Nevada state boundary line.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 31 and 36, T. 13 S., Rs. 45 and 46 E., with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound
of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
From this corner, State Line Monument No. 93, a drill hole in solid rock beneath a mound of stone on crest of rocky peak, bears N. 46° 50' W., 210.67 chs. dist.

35.30 Gulch, course NE.

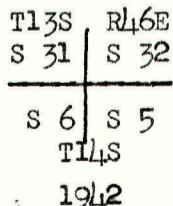
39.90 The original cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 S., Rs. 45 and 46 E. is a basalt rock, 14x12x12 ins., firmly set, mkd "13S" on N. face, "36E" on E. face, "14S" on S. face, "47E" on W. face, and six notches on each of its four edges, with a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high to the S. I add WP to the original markings.

Land, rolling desert hills.
Soil, rocky clay, 3rd rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, shadscale, creosote brush, cactus.
Grazing, poor.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH EDY. OF T. 13 S., R. 46 E.

Reestablishment of the surveys executed by Melvin D Heist, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1906.

The original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, Ts. 13 and 14 S., R. 46 E. is a basalt rock, 18x12x8 ins., mkd. 5 notches on E. edge, 1 notch on W. edge, firmly set in a mound of stones. At point for cor., Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original corner rock deposited at the base, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound
of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Thence,

West, on true line, bet. secs. 6 and 31, (east half mile.)

Over rolling and broken desert hills thru scattering undergrowth.

32.10 Wide shallow draw, drains N.70°E.
