General Description.

Township 39 N., R. 35 E., is situated northwesterly about 40 miles distant from Winnemucca, Humboldt County, Nevada.

The land varies from nearly level in the western portion to mountainous in the extreme eastern portion. The soil is a sandy, alkaline clay, 3d rate, unfit for agriculture, with no timber and covered by a scattering undergrowth of sagebrush and shadscale, unfit for grazing.

In the eastern portion of the township, in the Slumbering Hills, are the Pick Handle and Spanish Girl mines, neither of which is being worked intensively.

This township is suitable for mining only.
